- Matthew, formerly known as Levi was a tax collector
- A disciple/ apostle
- One of the four Evangelists
- The name Matthew is derived from Hebrew meaning "Gift of Yahweh".
  - When called by Jesus Matthew left behind his riches, place of safety and work, for traveling, hard times and eventually martyrdom.

- St. Matthew organizes his facts in groups of 3,5 and 7.
- Matthew may have written his book in Aramaic first then it translated to greek.
- Matthew may have written his book in 70 A.D






- Targeted for a Jewish audience
- Showing Christ relations with Jewish traditions
- Showed jesus as a Jewish man by saying He is a descendant of Abraham
- A lot of references to the Old Testament
- Wants to tell the people that the Messiah has come
